

BIOLOGY CLUB CONSTITUTION

PREAMBLE: We, the members of the Biology Club, in order to provide an organization for the continued study of the life sciences, do establish this constitution.

ARTICLE I: Name

This organization of David H. Hickman High School shall be known as the Biology Club.

ARTICLE II: Subject

This organization has been formed in order to give students who have taken or are taking a course in biology, an opportunity to pursue interesting and educational activities which, because of limited time, are not included in their regular course of study.

ARTICLE III: Membership

Section 1: Membership is open to any student who has taken or is taking a course in biology.

Section 2: An unexcused absence the day before, or of a scheduled field trip will prohibit a member from attending the field trip.

Section 3: Misconduct on field trips or at meetings may result in loss of membership.

ARTICLE IV: Dues

The amount of dues will be decided by the executive board each year, and dues shall not exceed one dollar.

ARTICLE V: Election of officers

Section 1: The officers of Biology Club shall be:

President

Vice-President

Secretary

Treasurer

Section 2: They shall be elected at the last regular meeting of each school year.

Section 3: A majority of members shall constitute a quorum.

ARTICLE VI: Duties of Officers

President: He/She shall preside over all meetings and appoint any necessary committees of which he/she shall be an ex-officio member.

Vice-President: He/She shall preside over all meetings of which the President is unable to attend, and assist him/her whenever necessary. He/She may also act as the activities chairman and may undertake any correspondence regarding these jobs.

Secretary: He/She shall keep an accurate list of members and a record of their attendance at meetings. Also, he/she is expected to keep the minutes of business meetings. The Secretary will conduct any club correspondence.

ARTICLE VII: Faculty Sponsor

The faculty sponsor, or sponsors, shall advise the club in all it's activities.

ARTICLE VIII: This constitution may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the club members.
