Getting Your Club Approved By the Steering Committee

A Step By Step Guide

Obtain a Club Sponsor

The first step is finding a sponsor who can be present and provide a room for club meetings. Before you propose your club to Steering, get a Hickman staff member to commit to being your club sponsor.

Find at Least 5 Students Who Are Interested

There's no official minimum number of students for a club at Hickman, but to hit the ground running, it's probably a good idea to make sure your club will have at least five students to attend the first meeting.

Make a Club Constitution and Submit it Digitally

Your club needs to have a Constitution before you can present it to Steering. Your club's sponsor and preliminary club members should all agree on your Constitution. Once the document is ready, submit it digitally below:
